Dan Tufis is a full member of the Romanian Academy and Professor of Computational Linguistics. He is the Director of the Institute of Artificial Intelligence in Bucharest (since 2002). He graduated from the faculty of Computer Science of the 'Politehnica' University of Bucharest in 1979, obtaining a PhD from the same university in 1992. His contributions (paradigmatic in NLP morphology, POS tagging, WSD, QA, MT, word alignment, large mono- and multilingual corpora and dictionaries, wordnet, etc.)

have been published in more than 300 scientific papers.

He received various distinctions and prizes for his research throughout his career and is currently Doctor Honoris Causa of the University Agora of Oradea and Honorary professor of the University "A.I. Cuza" of Iași. He is a member of the Editorial Boards of several international journals. His research interests include natural language processing, machine translation, knowledge representation, semantic web.
