Savvas A. Chatzichristofis received his Diploma and Ph.D. with honors in Electrical and Computer Engineering from the Democritus University of Thrace, Greece. He is Professor of Artificial Intelligence, Vice-Rector for Research and Innovation, and Director of the Intelligent Systems Laboratory (ISLab) at Neapolis University Pafos. His work centers on Artificial Intelligence in Education, with emphasis on pedagogy-aware uses of generative AI, trustworthy and ethical classroom integration, assessment and feedback at scale, teacher professional development, and evidence-based policy support.

He serves on the Cyprus National AI Taskforce and has led large outreach programs for schools and society. His publication record exceeds 110 peer-reviewed outputs across journals, conferences, and edited volumes, supported by more than twenty years of research and leadership experience. In 2025 he received the All Digital Award in the AI and Emerging Tech category for public scholarship and training initiatives. He has received distinctions, grants, and scholarships recognizing contributions at the intersection of AI, education, and society.
